Second letter to the International Schoenstatt Family

Dear International Schoenstatt Family,

Again and again we are asked: Will the centre at Belmonte be finished when the Schoenstatt Family from all over the world celebrates its centenary in October 2014 in Rome?

Our answer: We hope so! Why this tentative reaction?

The DOMUS PATER KENTENICH is far advanced. The growing solidarity of many people also becomes increasingly clear. I thank you all most sincerely. Once the windows have been put in everywhere, the house will almost look complete. The plumbers are busy inside. They hope to have completed the installation of all pipe work and wiring by the end of the year. Then the internal plastering and flooring will follow, and finally the tiling, carpeting, doors and furnishings will have to be done. Outside the house the site has to be landscaped, retaining walls built, sewerage and cables buried, and the parking areas and paths have to be laid.

Slowly reactions and help are arriving from other communities in the international Schoenstatt Families in various countries. It has become noticeable since my first open letter. The first countries have agreed to finance a room. Of the 220 pillars that have been financed, two-thirds have been donated by individual people, courses and countries outside the Priests' Institute. These are important signs of hope for us. They show that Belmonte can really become a centre for the whole international Schoenstatt Family.

Nevertheless we are all challenged to help as far as we can so that our Father's House can be completed by 2014.
